**NOTIFICATION OF WORK TO MAINTAIN THE A5 CARRIAGEWAY,
NORTHBOUND BETWEEN LONGSHOOT JUNCTION AND MIRA ROUNDABOUT**

I am writing to advise you that we will shortly be carrying out resurfacing and drainage survey work on the northbound A5, starting at the A47 Longshoot junction. The work is due to start on Monday 20 February and will take approximately 8 nights to complete, subject to weather conditions.

The resurfacing work is necessary for safety, as sections of the existing northbound carriageway between the A47 Longshoot Junction and MIRA Roundabout have been identified as having inadequate skidding resistance. We will also be carrying out drainage surveys between Higham Roundabout and Wood Lane, which will provide us with information required to complete the design of a future drainage maintenance scheme within that area.

Please note these works are separate to previous works undertaken at the Longshoot junction, and the proposed works at Dodwells.

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need overnight closures of the carriageway in both directions. We will put in place clearly signed diversion routes, which we have agreed with the local authority, using the A47 and A444. The local route from Higham on the Hill to Nuneaton through Higham roundabout will remain open. Work will take place Monday to Friday, between 8pm and 6am. We will keep the carriageway open as normal during the daytime and during the weekend.

Access will be maintained for local residents and businesses within the scheme extents, and this will be via escort through the works. Please contact our contractor at the telephone number below if you require this service at any time.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption but there will inevitably be a small amount of disruption generated by these works. However, by planning these works together we can reduce the overall disruption to local residents by making best use of the road closures, and maximising the work carried out.

Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
